School: Miami-Yoder School District 60 is approximately 6 miles away at Rush. K-12. Kids are bused 5 miles to & from school.

Great Horse Property. Level to gently rolling parcel includes 160 acres of vacant grassland pasture which offers many home sites to choose from. Plenty of room for barns, arenas, corrals & whatever else suits your fancy. A dry-sandy creek bed transects the property from the northwest corner downward toward the southeast corner. The creek bed area is a flood plain. But, there are plenty of nice home sites that are high & dry & out of the flood plain area. Sandy creek beds are great areas to work your horses. Just think how quick they'll be in a hard surface-flat arena! And, the creek bed and its banks add a little character to the lay of the land. This parcel offers a lot of possibilities. Less than ½ mile of gravel-county maintained Ramah Highway leads to paved State Highway 94.

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
